

# Wilsey Cemetery

Olive Twp., Clinton Co., MI

The cemetery is located on Bond Road about a half mile north of Round Lake Road. The old South Olive Methodist Church is across the road to the west. The cemetery was sometimes called the Lemm Cemetery during the 19<sup>th</sup> century. The cemetery is divided into three sections: south, center and north. All readings were row by row from south to north. Row 0 refers to three graves at the front of the cemetery.
